

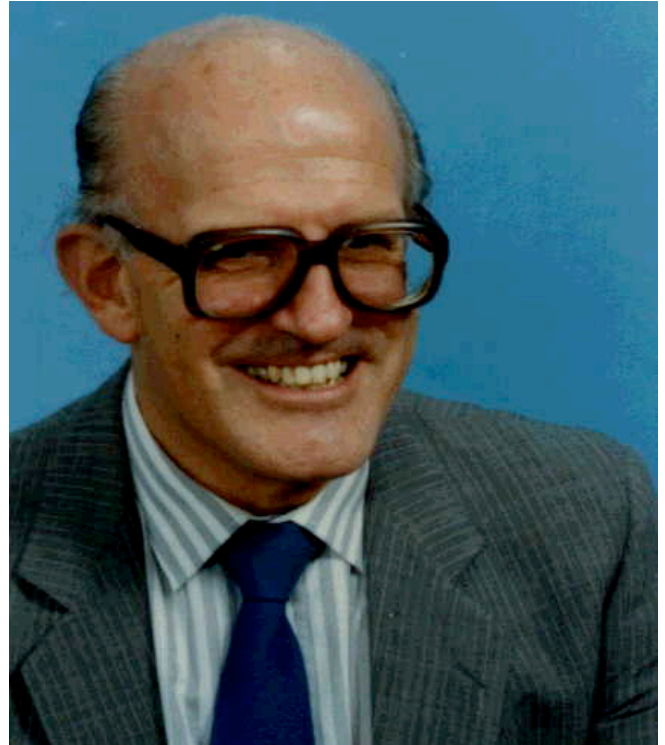
EuMA DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD

1932: Born in London
1953: Graduated BSc from Imperial College, MSc(Eng) and PhD from the University of London
1959: Established microwave research group at Queen's University Belfast
1963: Appointed as Professor at Leeds University, formed the microwave group
1967: Appointed as Professor at Queen Mary College London, formed the antenna group
1969: Proposed to the IEE the holding of the first European Microwave Conference in London
1979: Chairman of the European Microwave Conference
1989: Awarded with the European Microwave Prize

Other awards include:

J J Thomson Medal and Measurement Prize of the IEE
IEEE APS Distinguished Achievement Award

He chaired 5 international conferences

He is the Founder Editor of the IEE Journal *Electronics Letters*
He is Editor of the IEE *Electromagnetic Wave Series* with 51 volumes
He has served as a Vice-President of both IEE and URSI and was Treasurer of URSI from 1993-1999
He has received Honorary Doctorates from the Universities of Kent and of Aston in Birmingham

He has been a consultant to industry since 1960

He has served as the Chairman of the Technology Advisory Board of Filtronic plc from 1998
