The award is given each year during the European Microwave Week (EuMW)

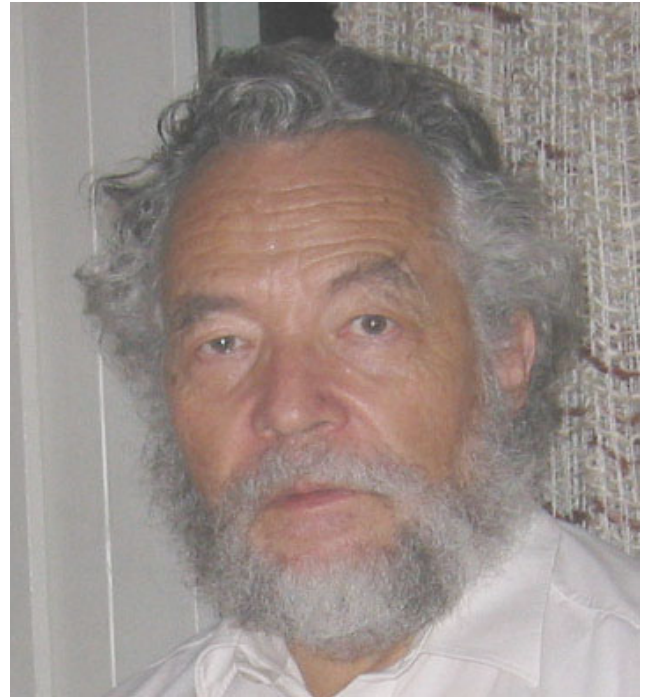
The award is a bronze medal carrying the name of the awarded

1965: MSEE degree in EE from MIT

1969: PhD in Applied Science from Louvain University, Belgium

1970: Professor and director of the Laboratory of Electromagnetism and Acoustics (LEMA) at the Ecole Polytechnique Fédérale of Lausanne

1973-1976: Chairman EuMC Management Committee

1974: Chairman of the 4th EuMC in Montreux

1997-1992: Chairman of the Swiss National URSI committee

1990-1993: Chairman of the International URSI commission B

He has authored 8 books and contributed more than 300 technical publications

He has served as Chairman IEEE Switzerland from 1975-1976

He is founder and 1st chairman of the IEEE Swiss joint MTT+AP Chapter

He was member of IEEE-APS AdCom from 1988 - 1990
